

Tomáš Prošek leads the Department of Metallic Construction Materials in Technopark Kralupy of the University of Chemistry and Technology in Prague. His group focuses on corrosion protection in building and automotive industries and material safety in presence of hydrogen. His research activities are aimed at understanding into principles of atmospheric corrosion, degradation mechanisms of coil-coated steel materials, development of metallic coatings, outdoor and accelerated corrosion testing,

corrosion monitoring and hydrogen embrittlement.
